

- A Government Issued ID & Social Security Numbers (document numbers for legal immigrants) for all household members.
- Employer and income information for every member of household who needs coverage (W-2s, pay stubs, tax statements, etc.)



Additional Information:

You should receive a letter from the state program that your application was received within 30 days. This letter will tell you who is eligible for the program and who is not. If someone is not eligible for the program, the letter will tell you why. It will also tell you what you can do next.
